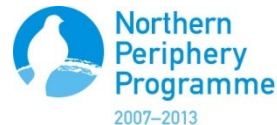

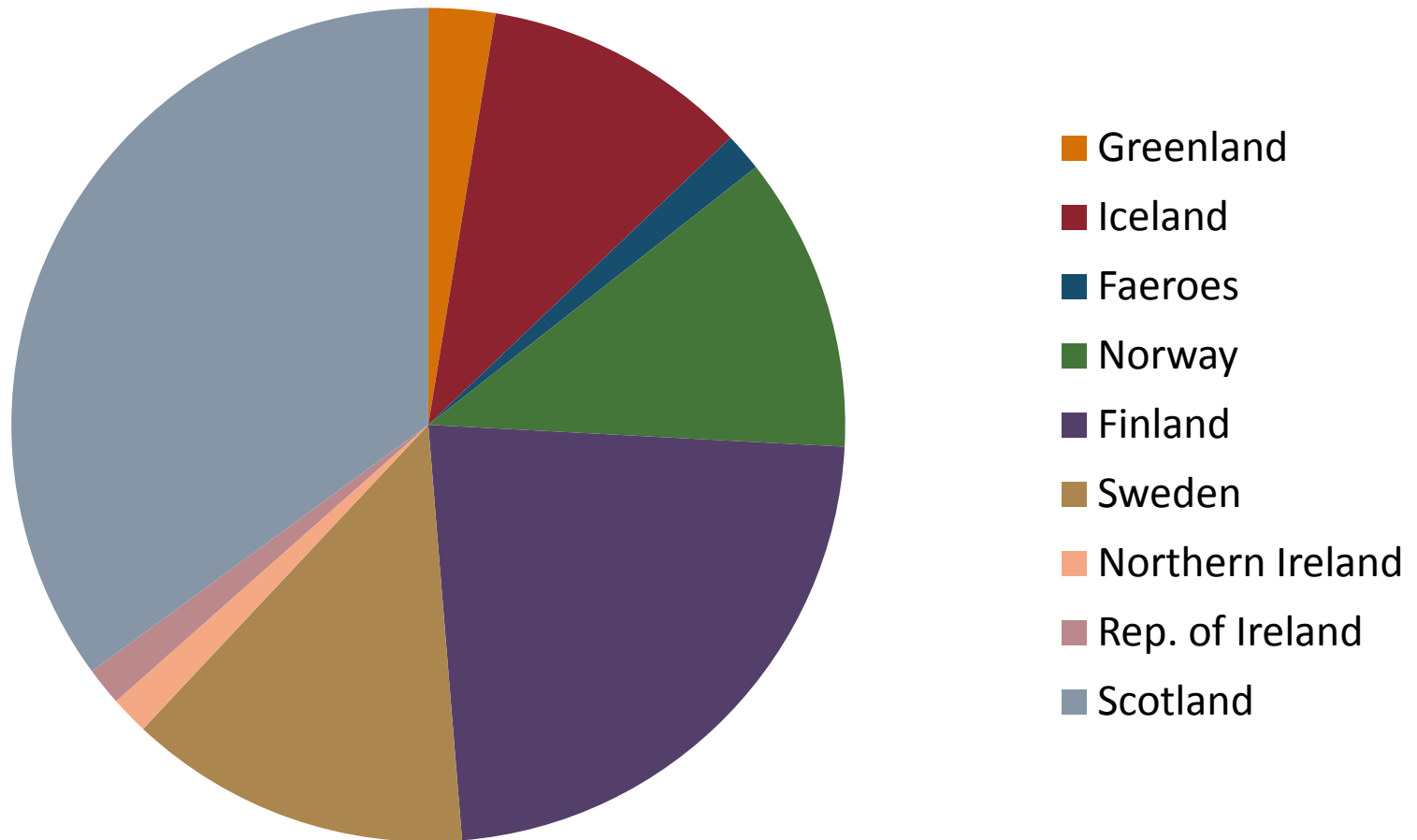

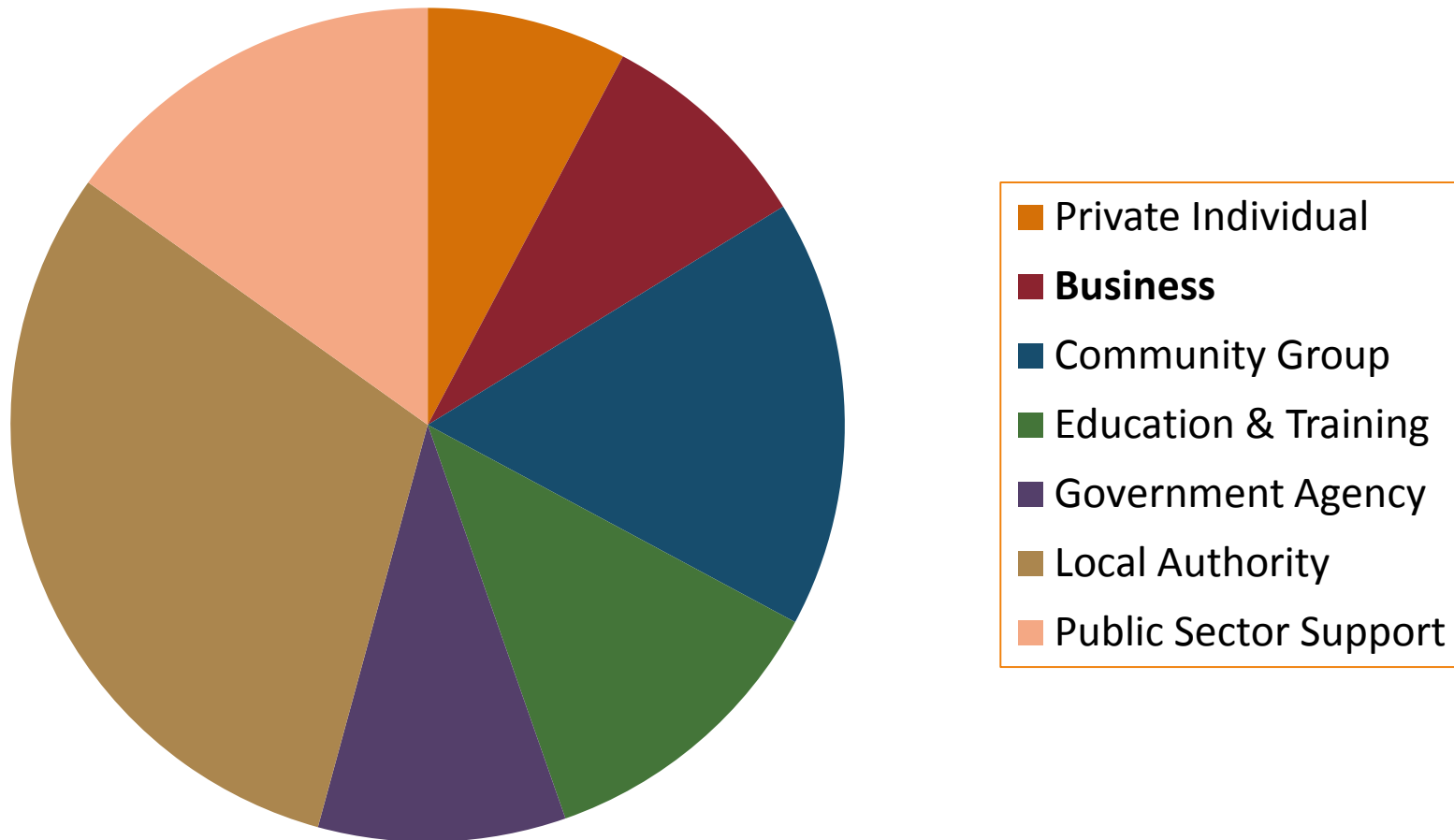
# The Approach

- Focus on *attitudes* and information needs about ***adaptation*** to climate change rather than mitigation
- The data are:
  - “exploratory” and can be used to look at similarities and differences between countries and organisations and individuals
  - “organic” : as more responses are gathered, better comparisons can be made
- The responses are “qualitative”, since issues can be further investigated by going back to selected respondents

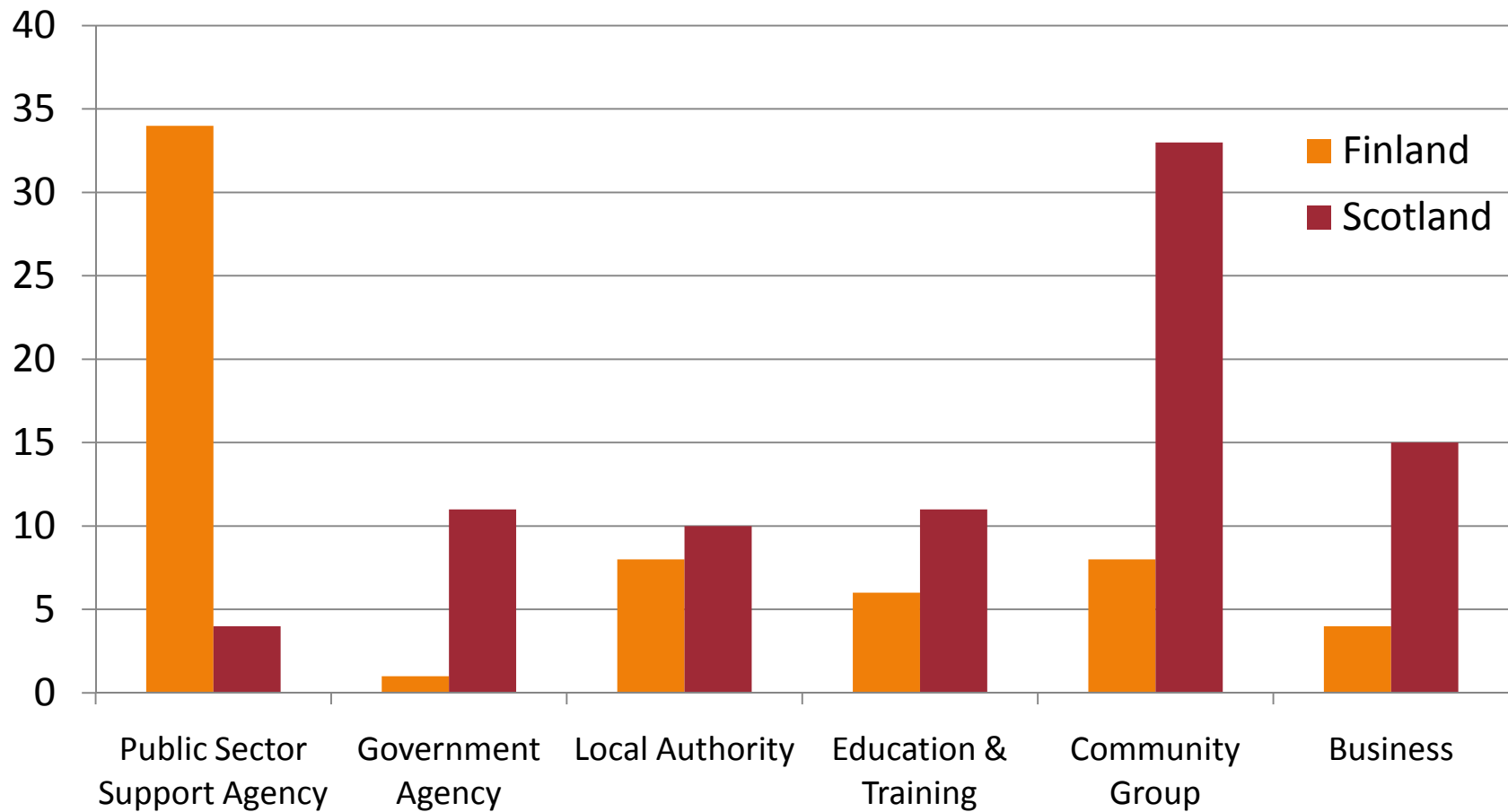
# Country of Respondents (total = 272)



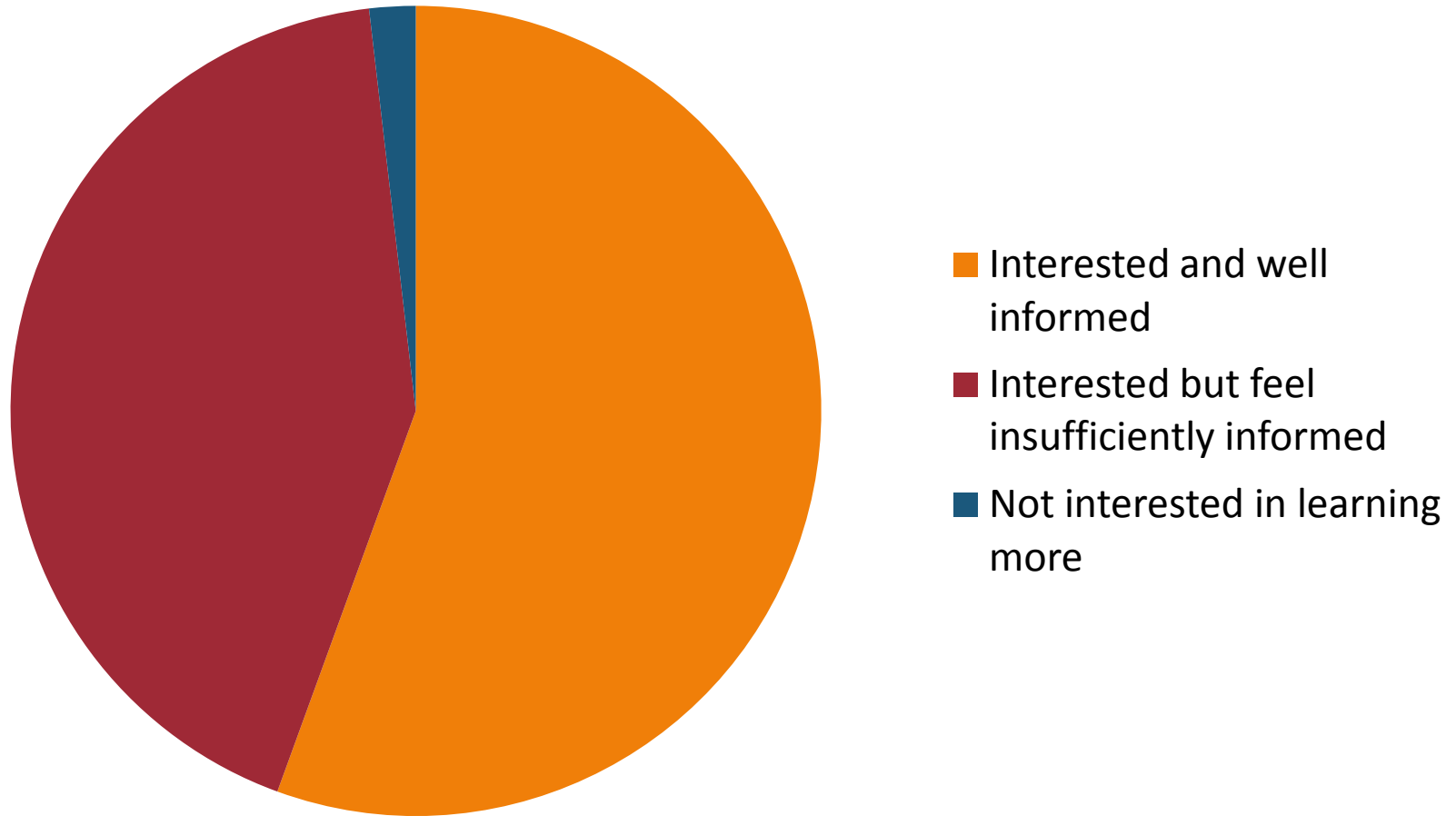
# Types of Respondents



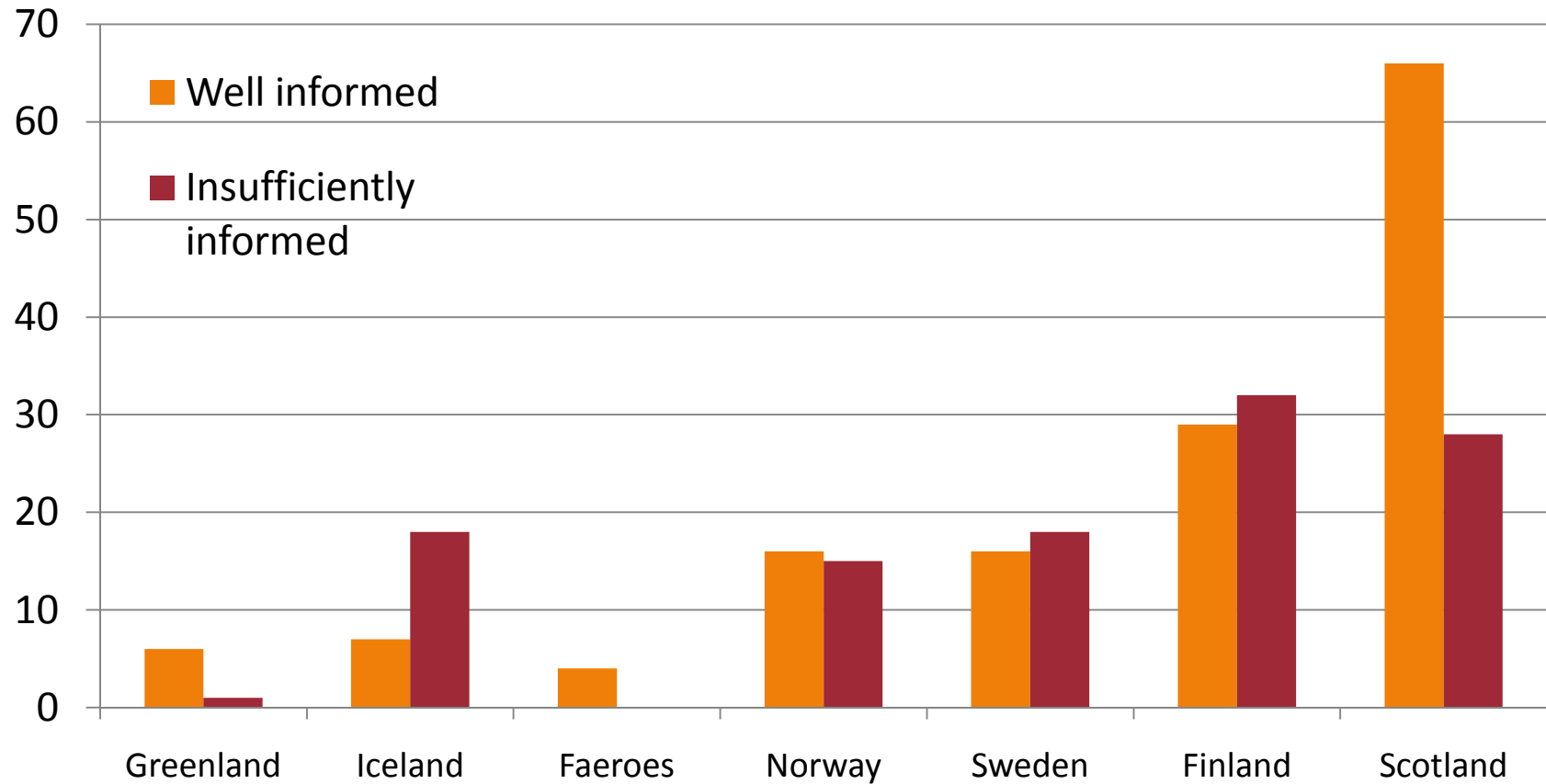
# Organisations: Finland (62) & Scotland (95)



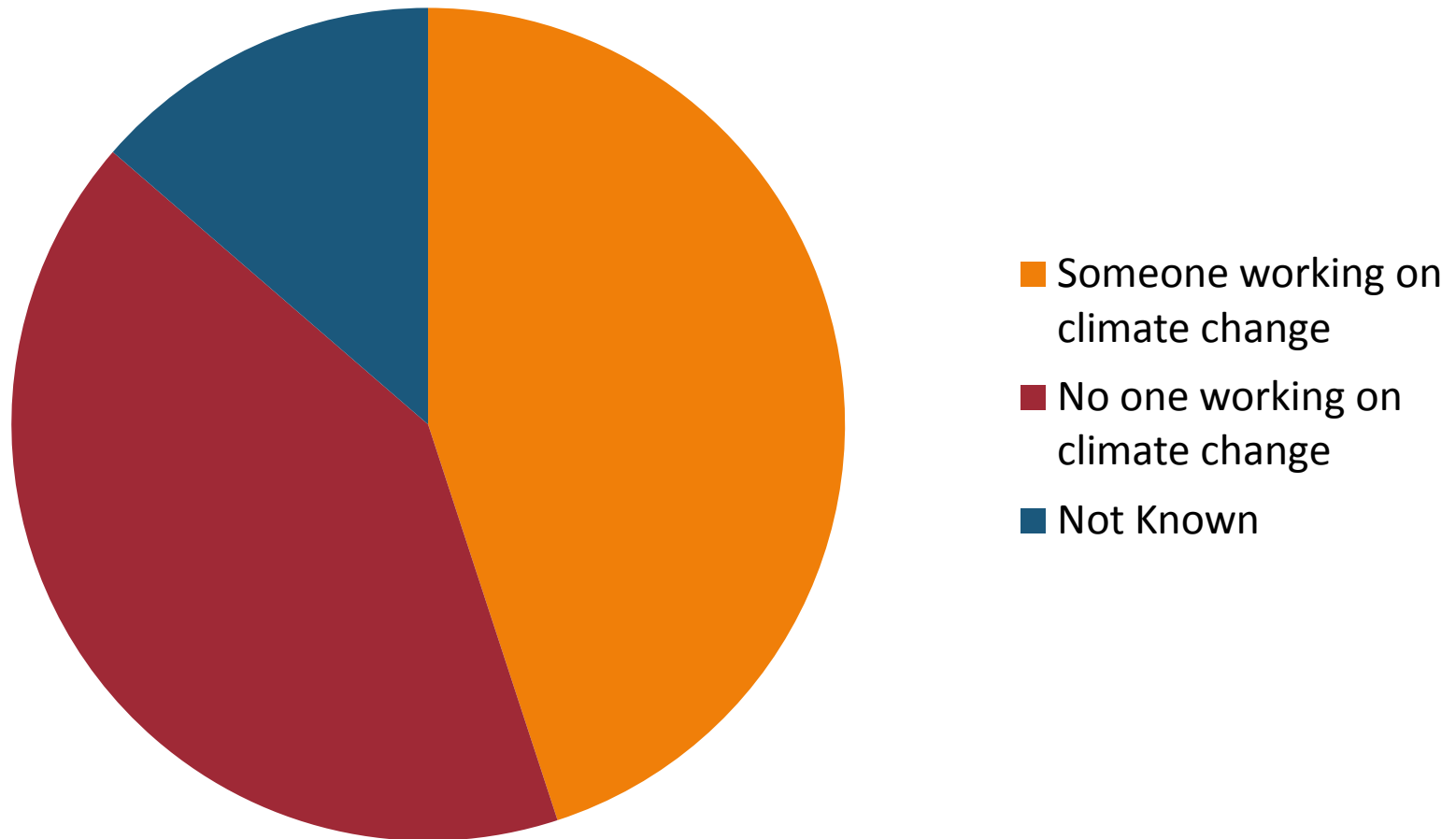
# Knowledge about climate change



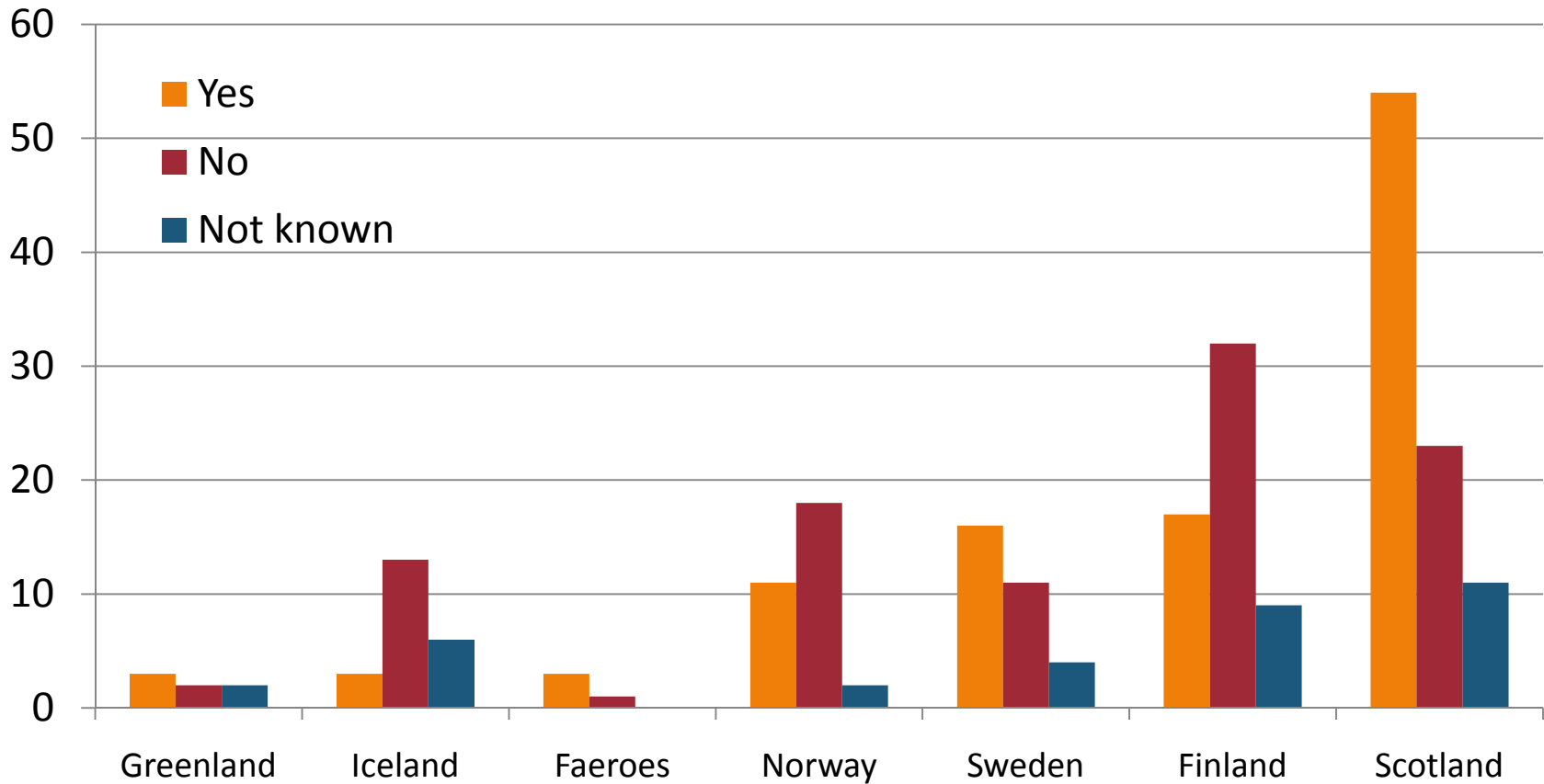
# Interested respondents: Knowledge about climate change by country



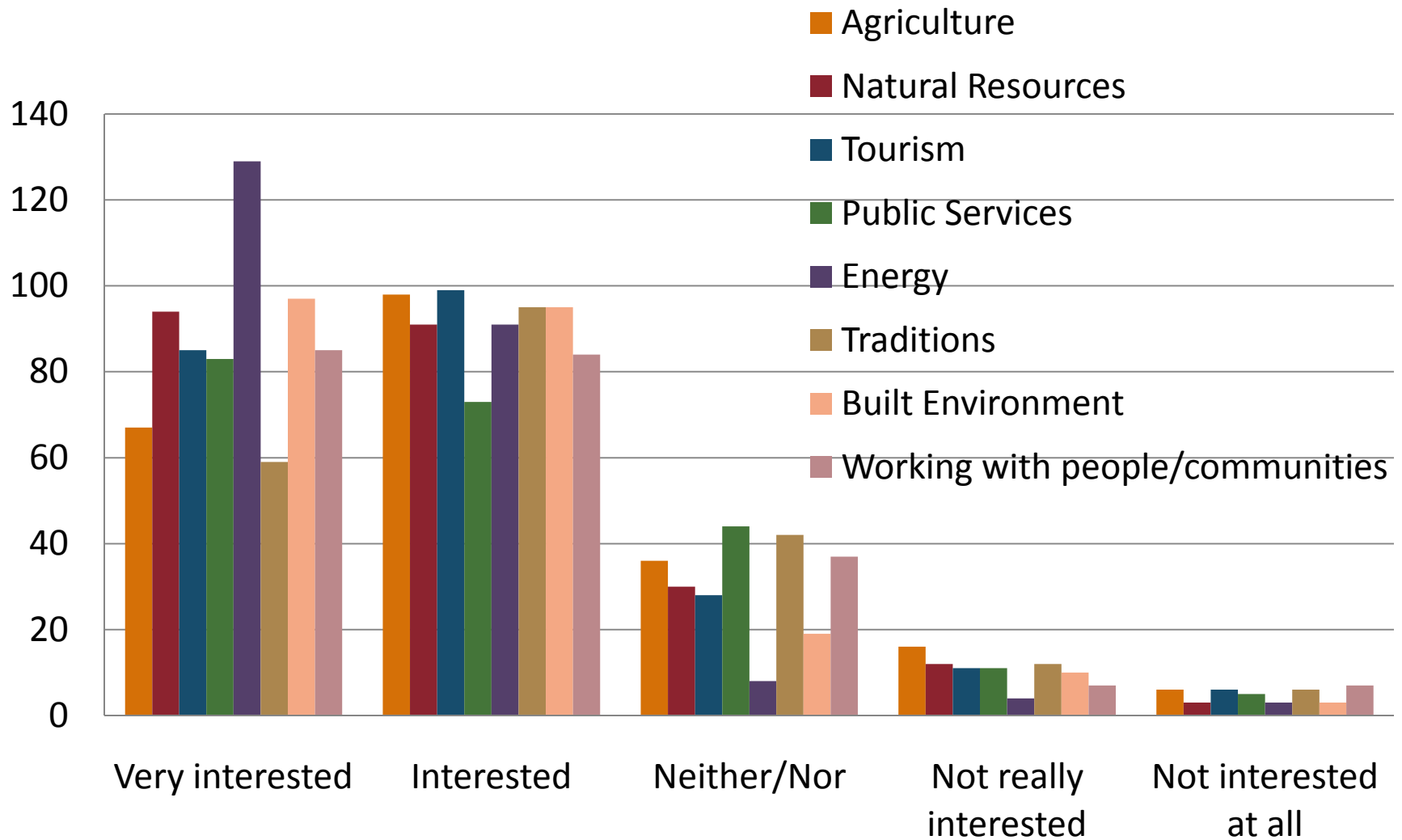
# Someone in the organisation working on climate change adaptation



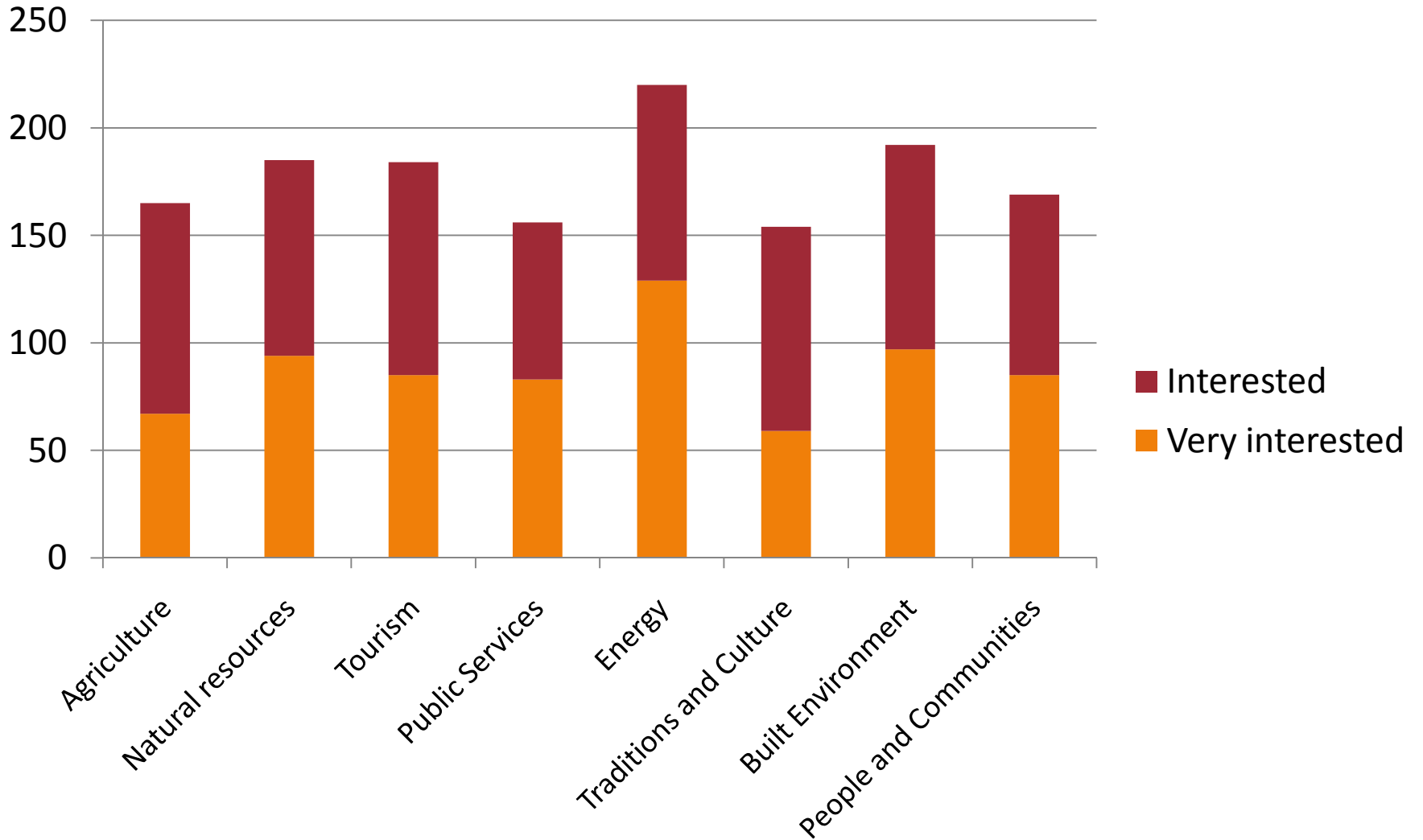

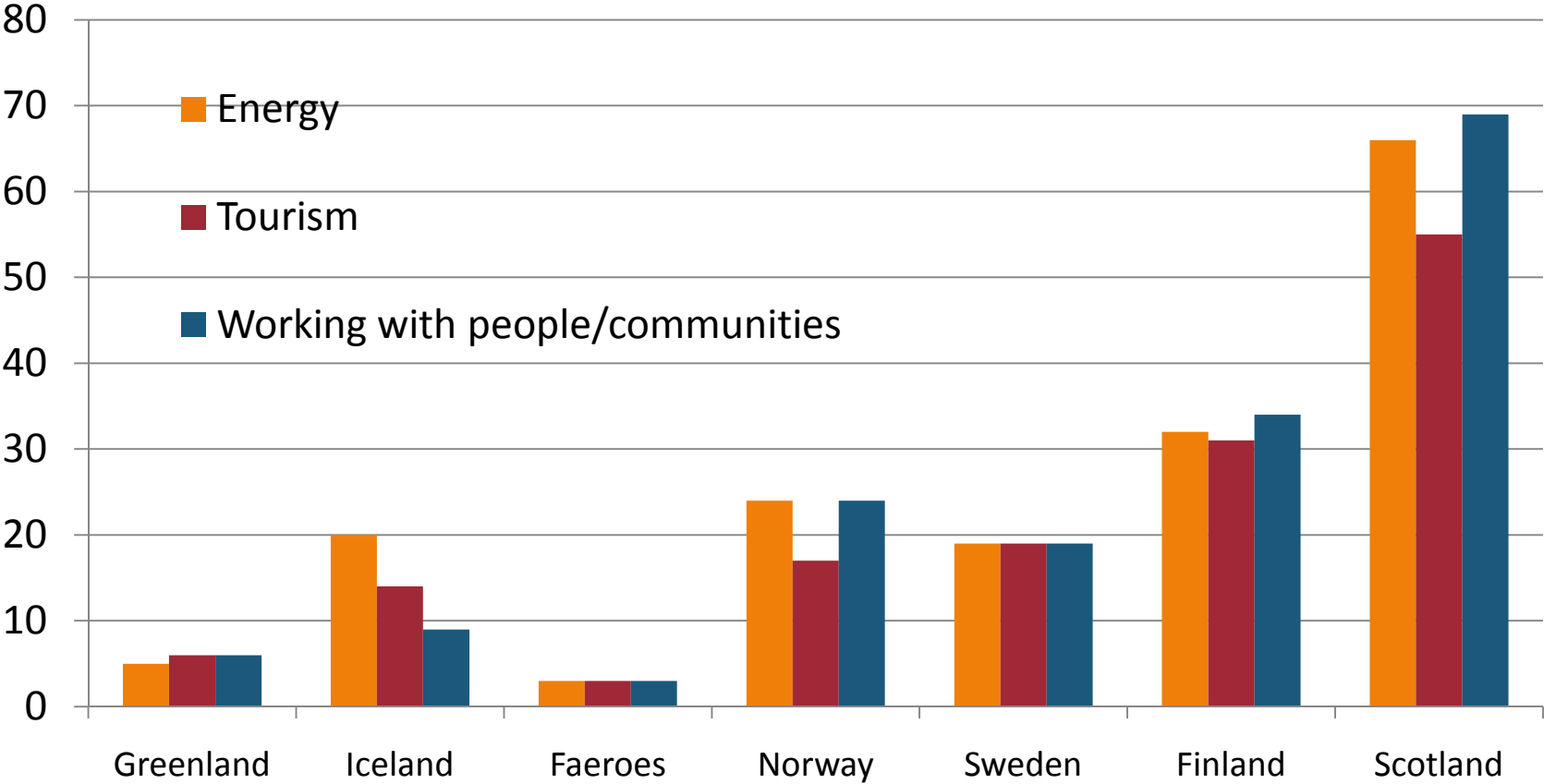

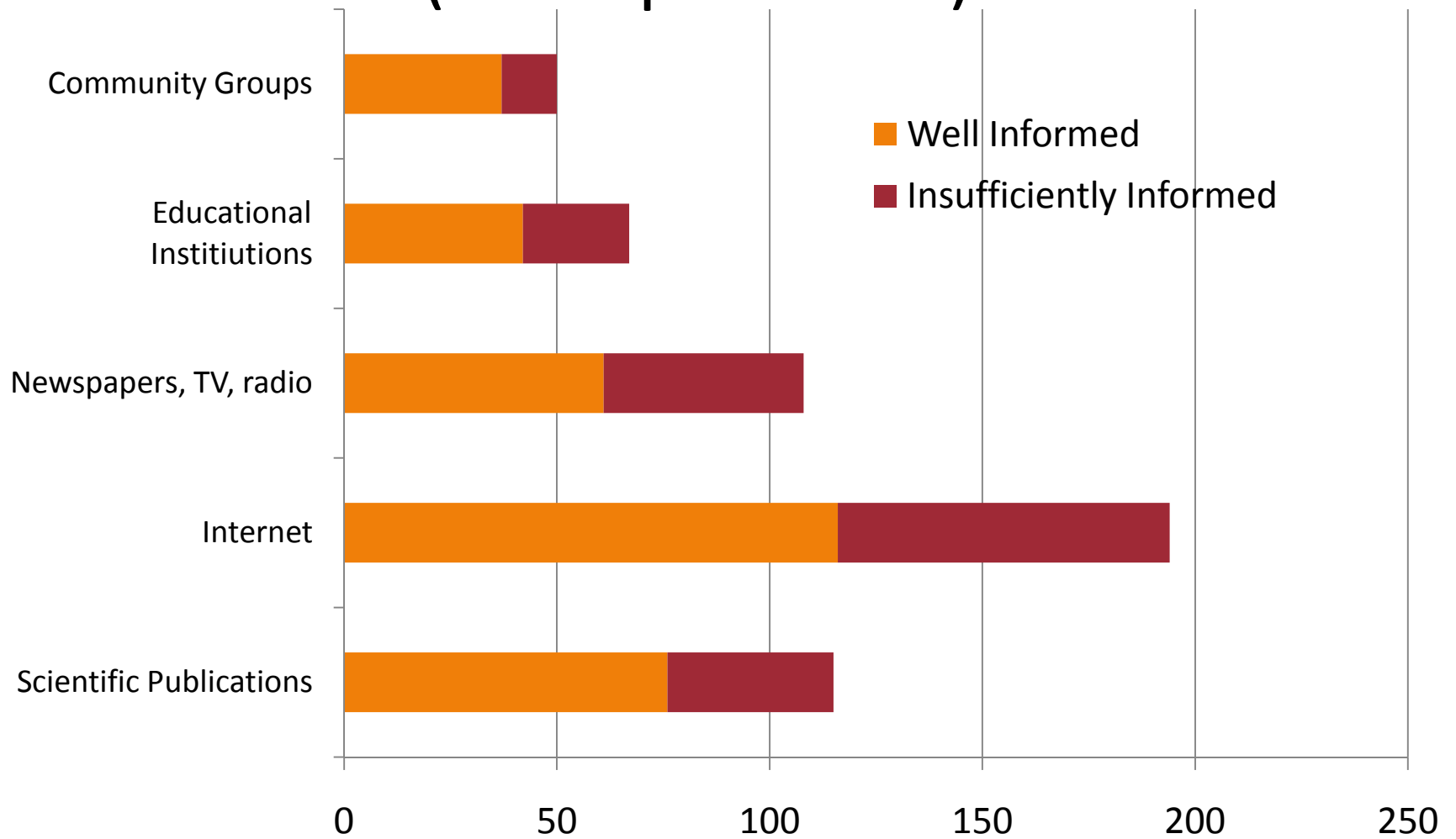
# Very/interested in knowing about adaptation



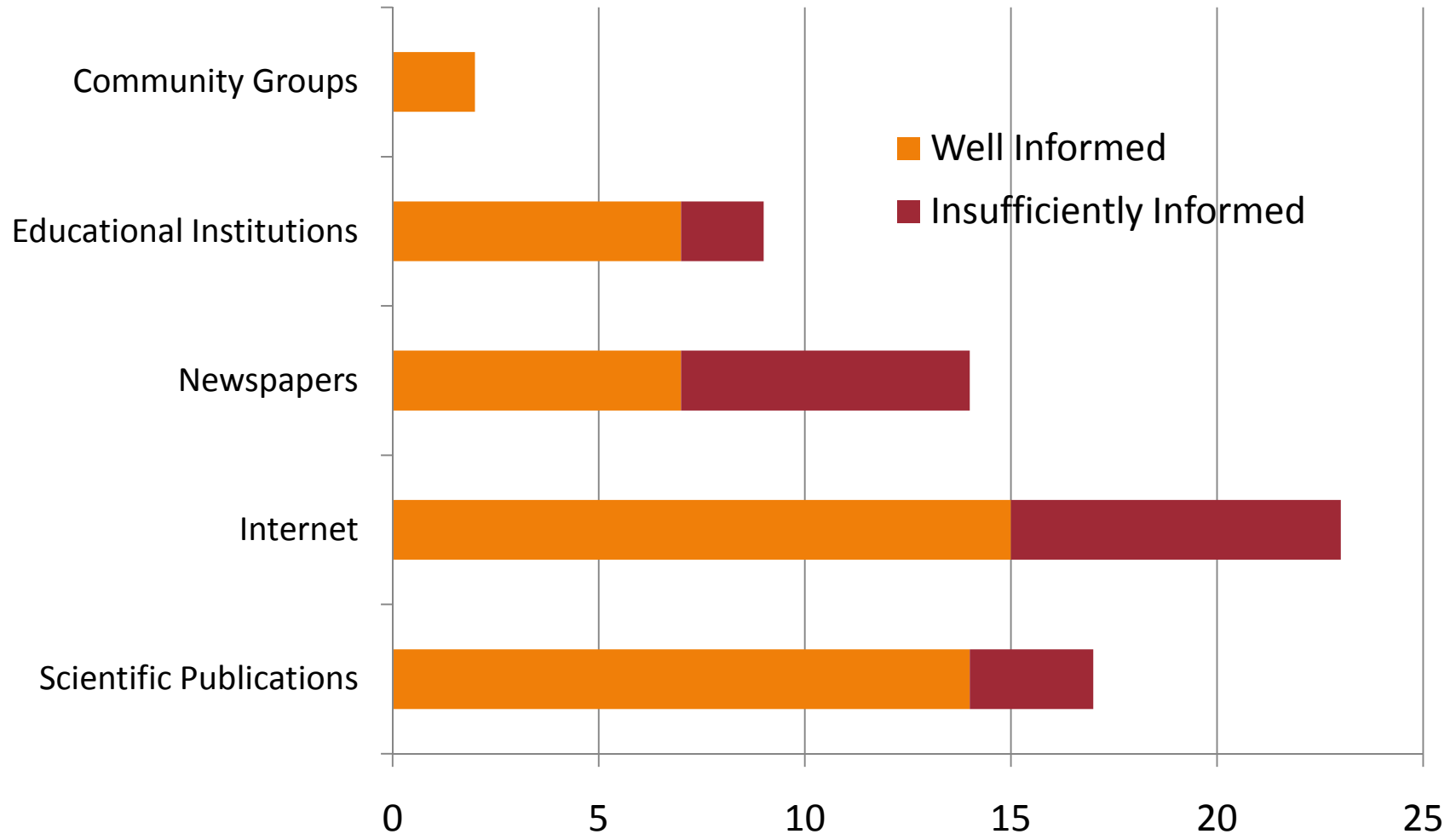
# Interest in sectors by country (very/interested)



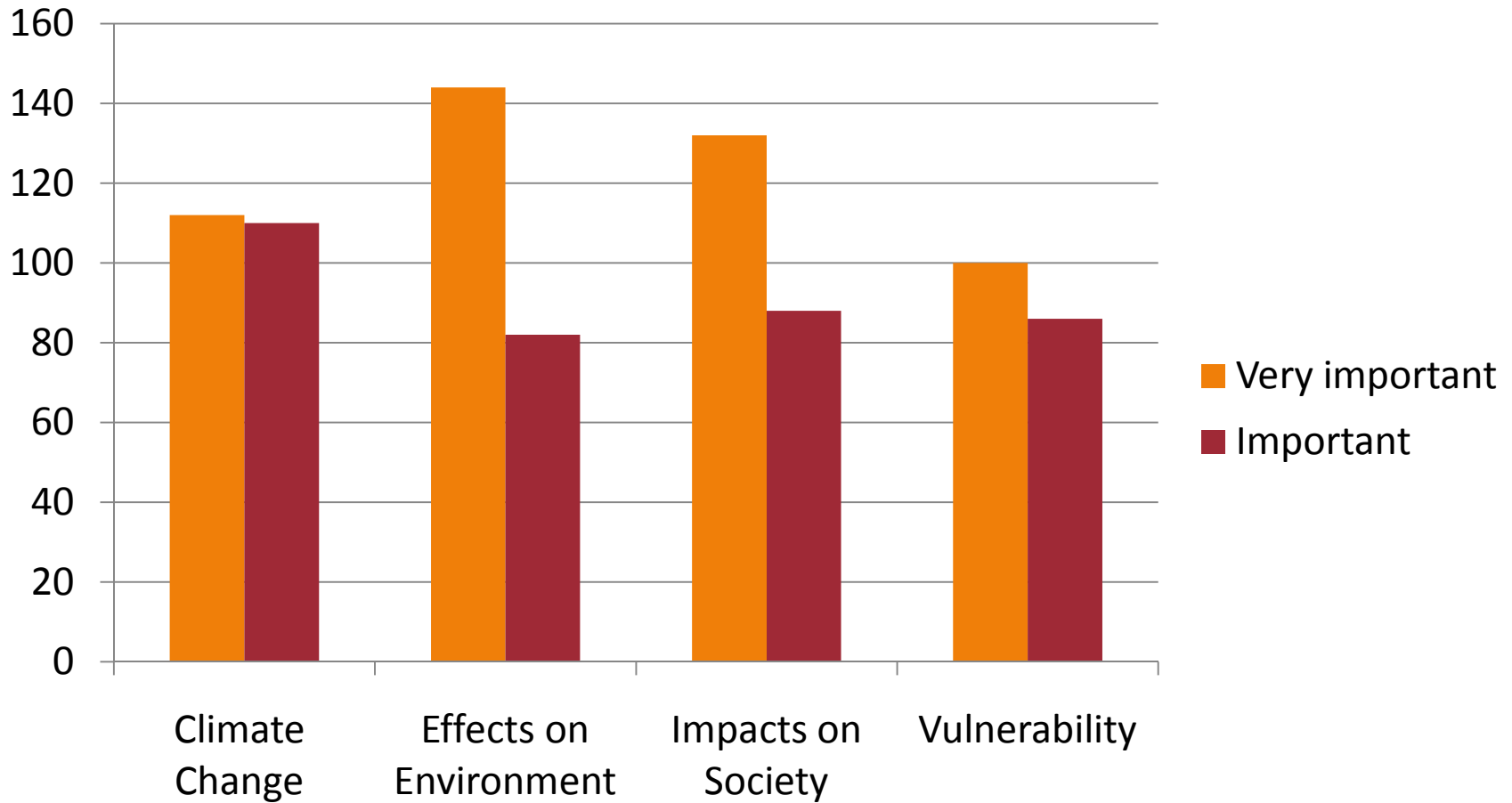
# Preferred Sources of Information (all respondents)



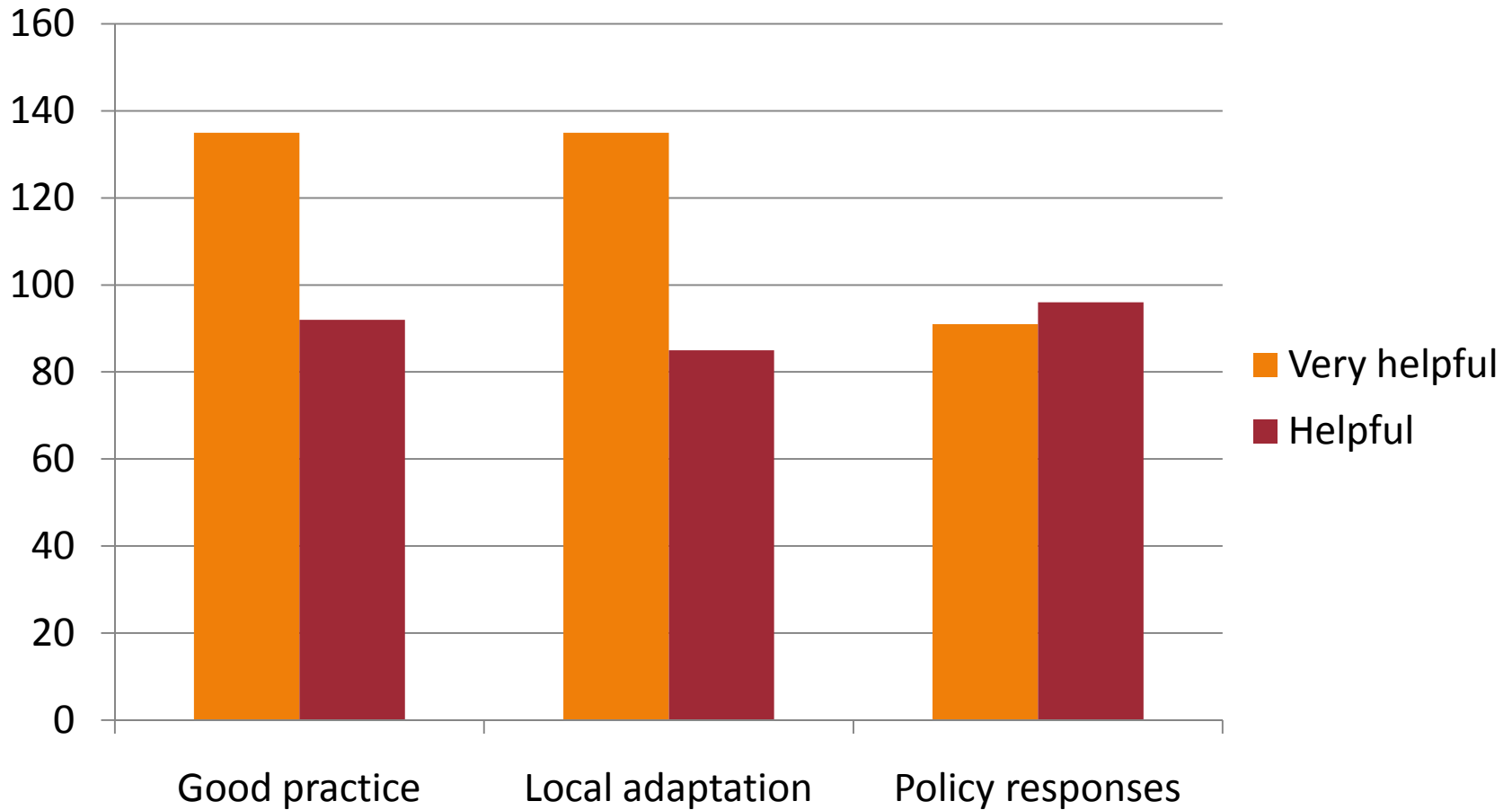
# Sources of information: Educational Establishments (32)



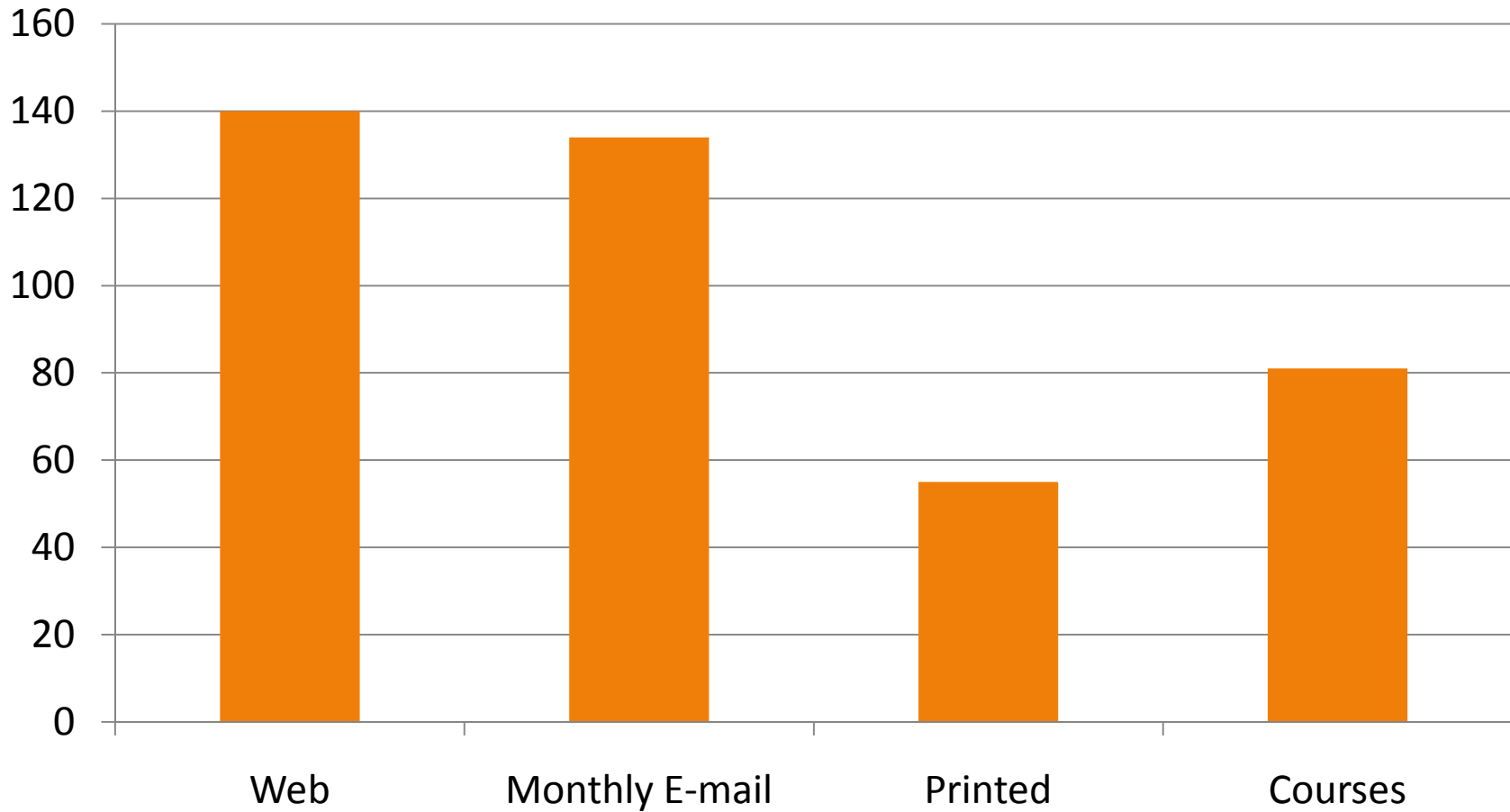
# Most beneficial information theme



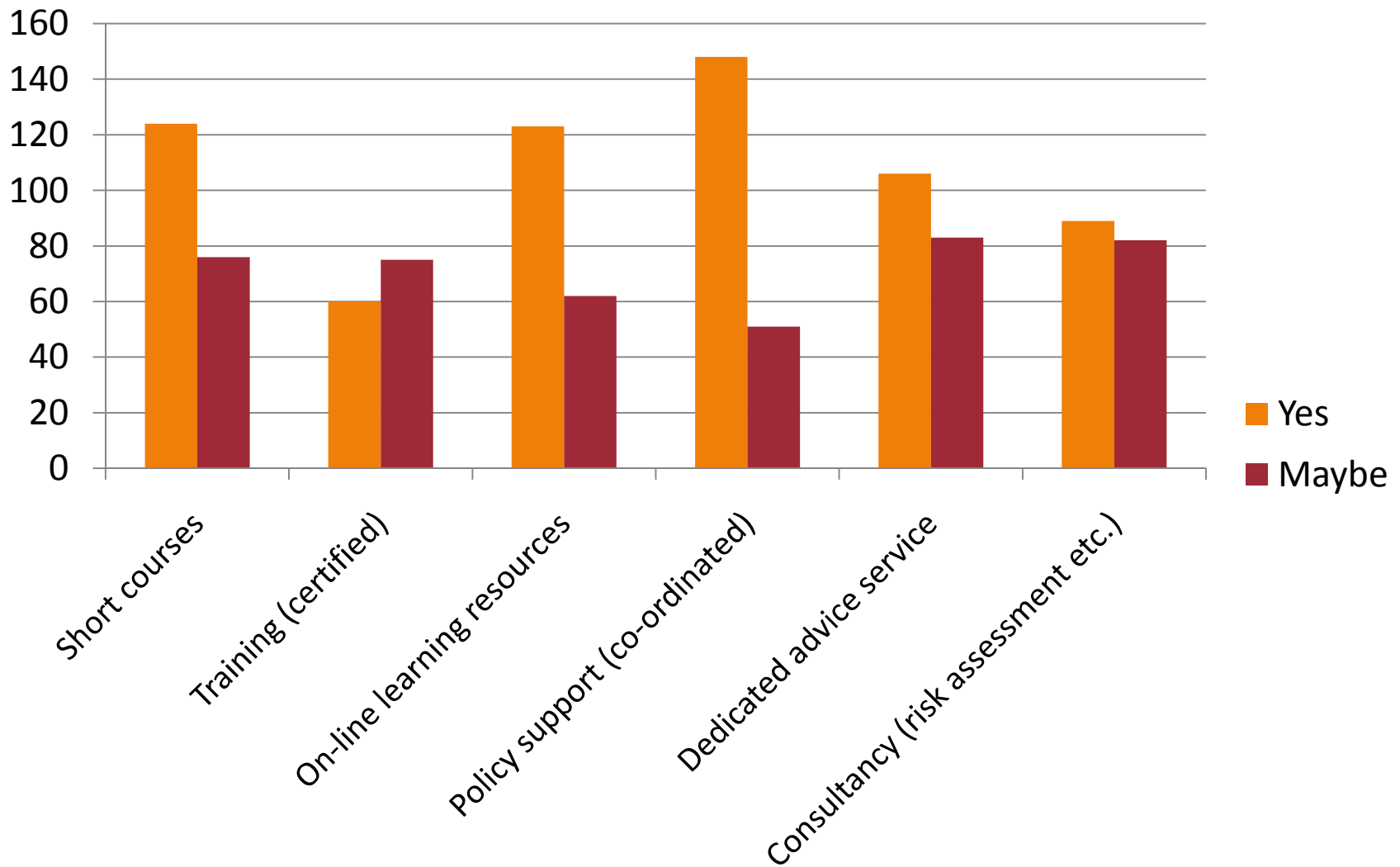
# Most helpful type of information
